
The Finley Hospital Laboratory Instructions for 24-Hour Urine Collection

1. DO NOT SAVE the f	irst urir	ne of the	day.	THROW AWAY	

2. WRITE the DATE and TIME that you throw away the first urine on the "Started" Line (above) and on the label on the jug.



3. **SAVE** all your urine for the next 24 hours. Pour each voiding in the top of the funnel with a fast even flow to assure equal splitting of the urine sample. (**This step is very Important!**)



4. **KEEP** the jug of urine **ON ICE OR IN** the **REFRIGERATOR**. The last time that you empty your bladder and save the urine should be 24 hours after step 2.



5. WRITE the DATE and TIME of the last urine saved on the "Stopped" line (above) and on the label on the jug. (The "Started" and "Stopped" times should be the same, just 24 hours apart.)



- 6. You may call the lab at 563-589-2431 if you have any questions.
- Return the entire 24 hour collection to the laboratory as soon as possible.
 Note: Your collection container may be labeled with a "Caustic" warning sticker indicating that a strong chemical has been added to the container as a preservative.

Contains a strong chemical preservative that may cause burns to body tissues. It may be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Contact a poison control center immediately
